**Grant Purpose (one paragraph)**

After-School All-Stars Tampa Bay provides free out-of-school-time educational programming at Title I schools in Tampa. We would use a grant from the White Family Foundation to support literacy and on-grade-level reading in the K-8 charter school we serve through our Bright S.T.A.R.S. (Students Targeted to Achieve Reading Success) initiative. Bright S.T.A.R.S. will use out-of-school time to provide literacy activities and opportunities to practice skills introduced during the school day. This program will use evidence-based curriculum and provide two hours of instruction per week for each grade level. It will also be offered during our summer program. Specifically, a grant would help fund curriculum and a literacy content expert for this initiative.
