Black Girl Magic Basketball Foundation (BGMBF) is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization based in Sunrise, Florida. The foundation was founded by its current CEO, Tamara Pluviose, in 2012 to support, uplift, and honor young Black girls— especially those who love to ball. BGMBF was established upon the idea that young Black female student-athletes should be given opportunities to be acknowledged, uplifted, and cultivated. BGMBF works to invest in, acknowledge, uplift, and cultivate the unbridled academic and athletic potential of Black female, high school and college students. BGMBF creates a platform for young, Black female athletes to forge their path to success by accomplishing their goals on and off the court.

**Grant Purpose (one paragraph)**

Grant funds will primarily be applied to the operation and expenses of the Black Girl Magic Basketball Foundation Pathways Program. Majority of the grant awarded will be used for the scholarships of the student-athletes registered in the said program. Part of the funds will also be utilized to expand organizational capacity and to develop policies and methods to ensure program sustainability. In addition, due to the changes brought by the pandemic, there is a need for BGMBF's services to be converted digitally, and such conversion entails additional expenses in terms of equipment and subscription for digital applications. In line with this, a part of the grant will be applied for such digital conversion.
