CASE STATEMENT

We are Sewing Hope, Inc., we make blankets to be given to Foster Children. We make these blankets out of soft, colorful polar fleece that are attractive to Foster Children. The blankets are special to each child as it is theirs to keep. Unlike clothing and shoes that wear out or get too small and will need to be replaced. Each child is surprised that the blanket that is given to them is to stay with them. We purchase the fabric by the yard and cut it into 1-yard pieces and serge around the edges so that it looks professional and tells them someone cares about them. Joann fabrics is good at giving us the fabric when they have special sales. That has been between \$3.00 & \$4.00 so \$4000.00 will give us enough fabric to make 1,000 blankets if the fabric is \$4.00 a yard. Many people are impacted by the blankets that these children receive: Biological Parents, Foster Parents, Case workers, Sheriff department employees, the Sheriff of Pinellas & Pasco counties.

PROBLEMS TO SOLVE

The Foster Children are made a part of the state because of stupid choices that their parents make. Each blanket is prayed for by the ladies that make them and our church. We want to show them that we love them and have made a blanket for them. There are 1500 Foster Children in Pinellas County & 900 Foster Children in Pasco counties. New ones are added and some age out.

HOW WE MEASURE PROJECT SUCCESS

Christina Needham of Florida Family Services comes to pick up the blankets and tells us stories of how well the blankets are being received. I started making blankets for Foster Children back in January 2010. The sheriffs of Pinellas and Pasco counties acknowledged that the blankets were given to each child. This year the Sheriffs requested that the blankets be made available to put into case worker's cars so could be given to the child when they were removed from the home. That was my original dream when this blanket project came into being in 2010, now it is a reality. Last month we made 91 blankets.

NEEDS FROM THE WHITE FAMILY FOUNDATION

We are asking for a \$4,000.00 grant so we can continue to make blankets to give to Foster Children within the Pinellas & Pasco counties.
